3. "Can I take you home tonight?"

How to respond:

"Aren't you sweet, I'll tell you later."

"What a nice thought. Let me think about that."

4. "Why are you still single?"

How to respond:

"That's my little secret. Why are *you* single?"

"Aren't you a curious guy?"

"Isn't that a puzzle? I'm still working on that."

"How nice of you to ask. Are you this curious about all women you talk to?"

5. "Why did you get divorced?"

How to respond:

"I can tell you that later. Let's talk about something upbeat."

"I'd rather focus on you — you're much more interesting."

"Didn't you hear, divorce is the new four letter word. Let's talk about your favorite movie instead."

6. "Do you want to hang out sometime?"

How to respond:

"What an interesting invitation."

"How nice of you to ask, I'll give it some thought."

"Can I get back to you on that?"

7. "How old are you?"

How to respond:

"A gentleman never asks and a lady never answers."

"Old enough to know better."

"Just the right age for whatever I want to do."

"I've finally arrived at the perfect age."

Choose your favorite responses and rehearse them before the next time you go out to meet men. Then, when you run into a jerk asking unwanted questions, you already know exactly what to say before you move on to meet better men.
